## Opening hours 8am to 5pm

The Park welcomes coaches and instructors who wish to participate with their students.

If you wan to come with your horse, you must be accompanied by a coach or instructor, if you do not have a coach, we can accompany you.

- A negative 2024 cogging test is required for your horse and must be sent before arrival to <a href="mailto:info@horselandparcequestre.com">info@horselandparcequestre.com</a>
- You must provide proof of vaccination 2024 against rhinopneumonia (herpesvirus) and influenza.
- You must sign the Lloyds waiver form prior to arrival.
- You must bring your hay and feed.
- You will be responsable for feeding and giving water to your horse.
- You must pick up your horse's manure everywhere on the site (even in the water).
- Horse that have cleats are not allowed in swimming pools.
- Stallions are not admitted.
- Dogs are not allowed on the premises.
- Videos are permitted for your horse only.
- The use of a helmet is recommended.
- Underage participants must have written permission from a parent.
- Equestrian sports and the handling of horses in general involve risks and dangers inherent in these
  activities. In the event of an accident, you acknowledge this fact and waive all claims for damages
  against the instructor and / or the owners of the site. You will need to sign a waiver form to this effect
  for the clinic host as well as the trainer.
- Cheval Quebec membership provides you with insurance in the event of an accident: <a href="https://cheval.quebec/adherer-benefices-assurances">https://cheval.quebec/adherer-benefices-assurances</a>
- At the end of your stay, you must clean and return your stall to the state it was in when you arrived.
- You are responsible to keep an eye on your horse so that it does not damage or break obstacle or decor. If so, you may have to pay for the damages.
- Due to current municipal regulations and beyond our control, it is not possible for anyone to stay
  in a trailer on site overnight. For your accommodation, we suggest that you contact Camping
  Alouette, neighboring Horseland.
